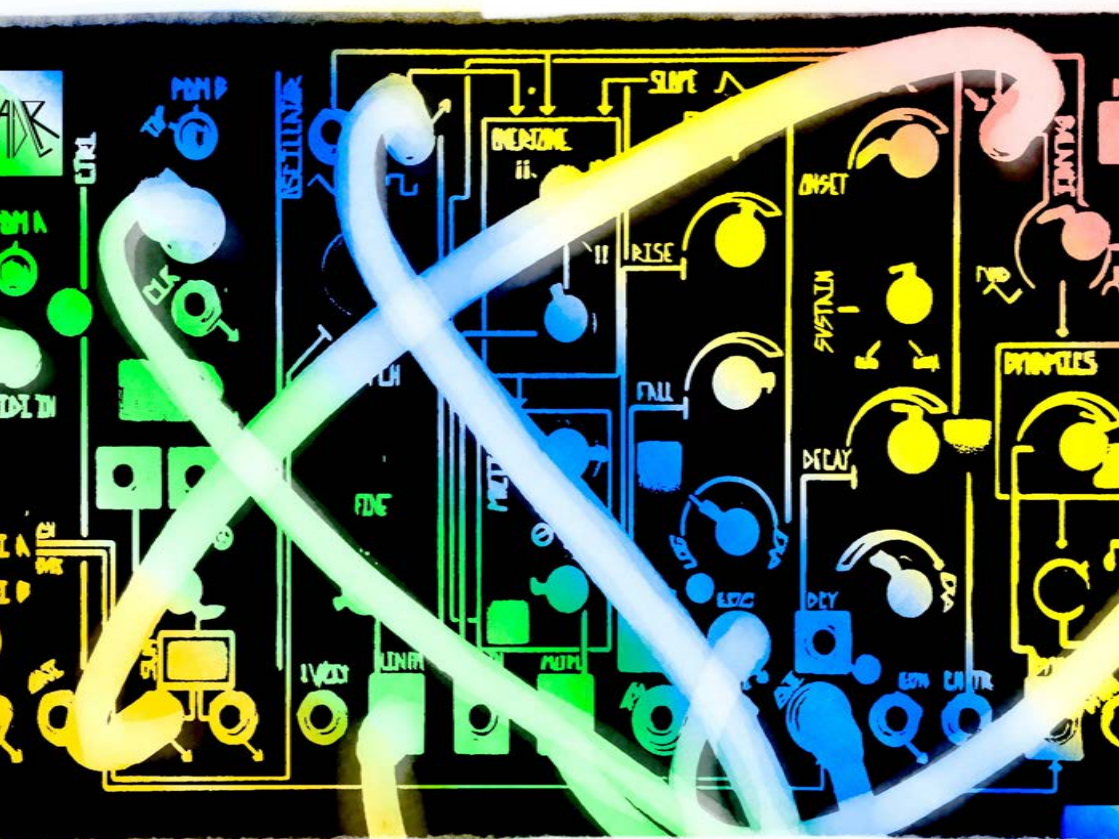

There are 50 artists included in this addition of the Rossendale Art Trail, including musicians, poets, painters, printers, street artist, textile artists and more. Some are newcomers, taking part for the first time, others are long established studio groups and professional artists.

Try and find time to see as much as you can. You'll find a useful map in the centre pages of this guide, and addresses for each of the venues along the edge of each page, with information on parking and accessibility on each listing.

Once again, we have the kind support and participation of Horse and Bamboo giving space for several artists to show and/or perform their work, and supporting the production of this guide.

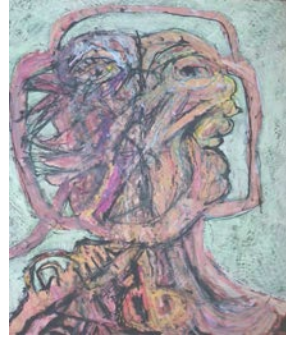

## KEITH NAYLOR

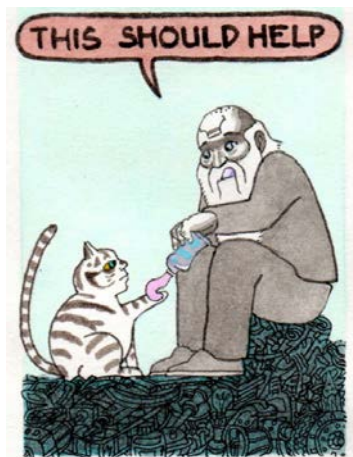

## SALLY BROADBENT

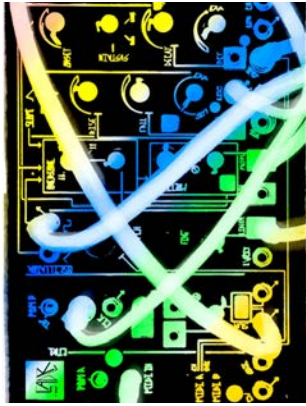

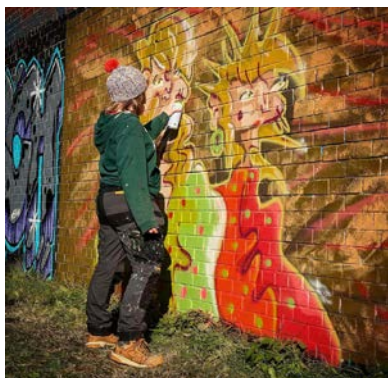
Passionately political yet gently understated, this is music that deftly treads the path between art and activism.


