She enjoys making domestic items that are individual artworks which are fun to use or wear.

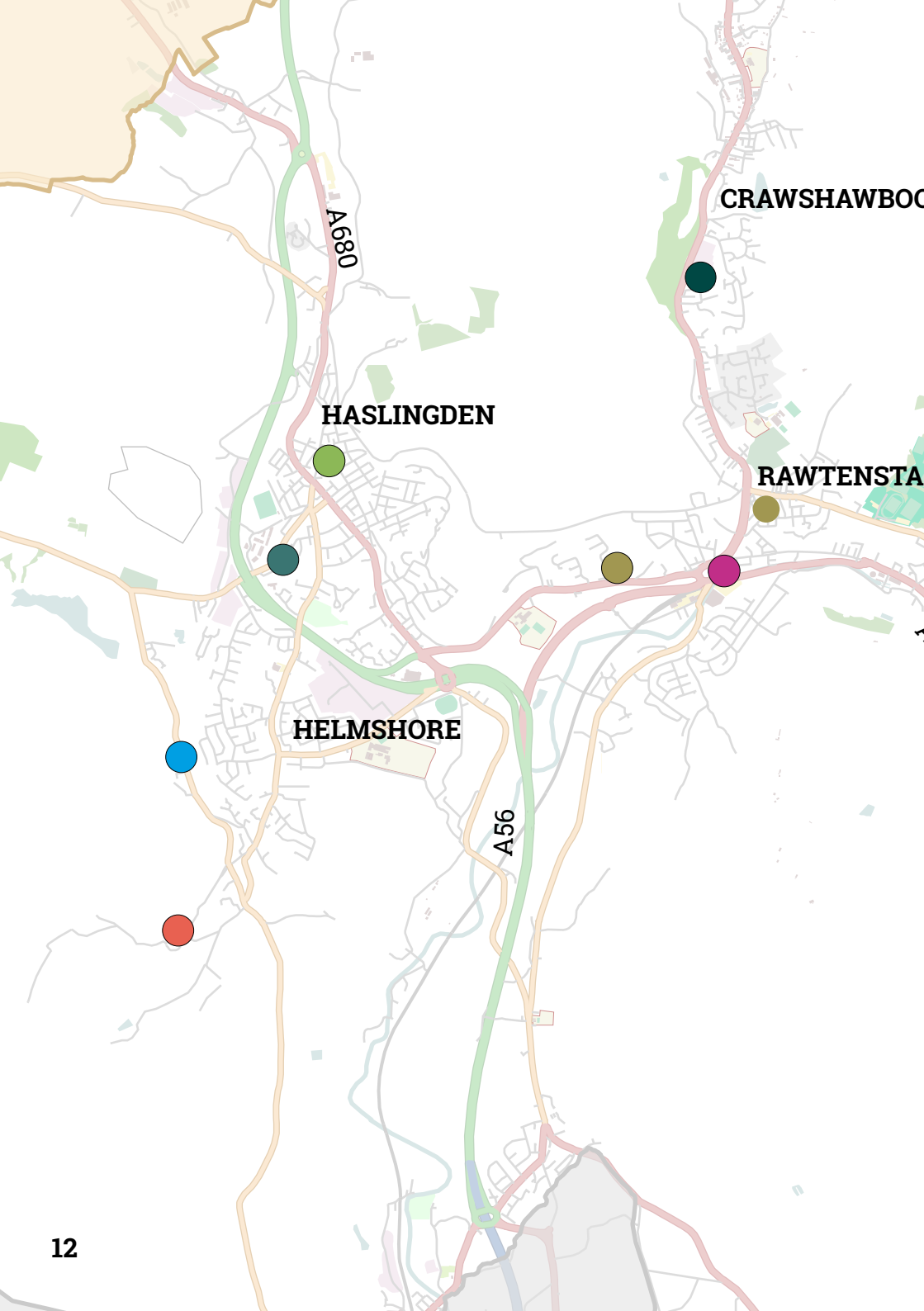

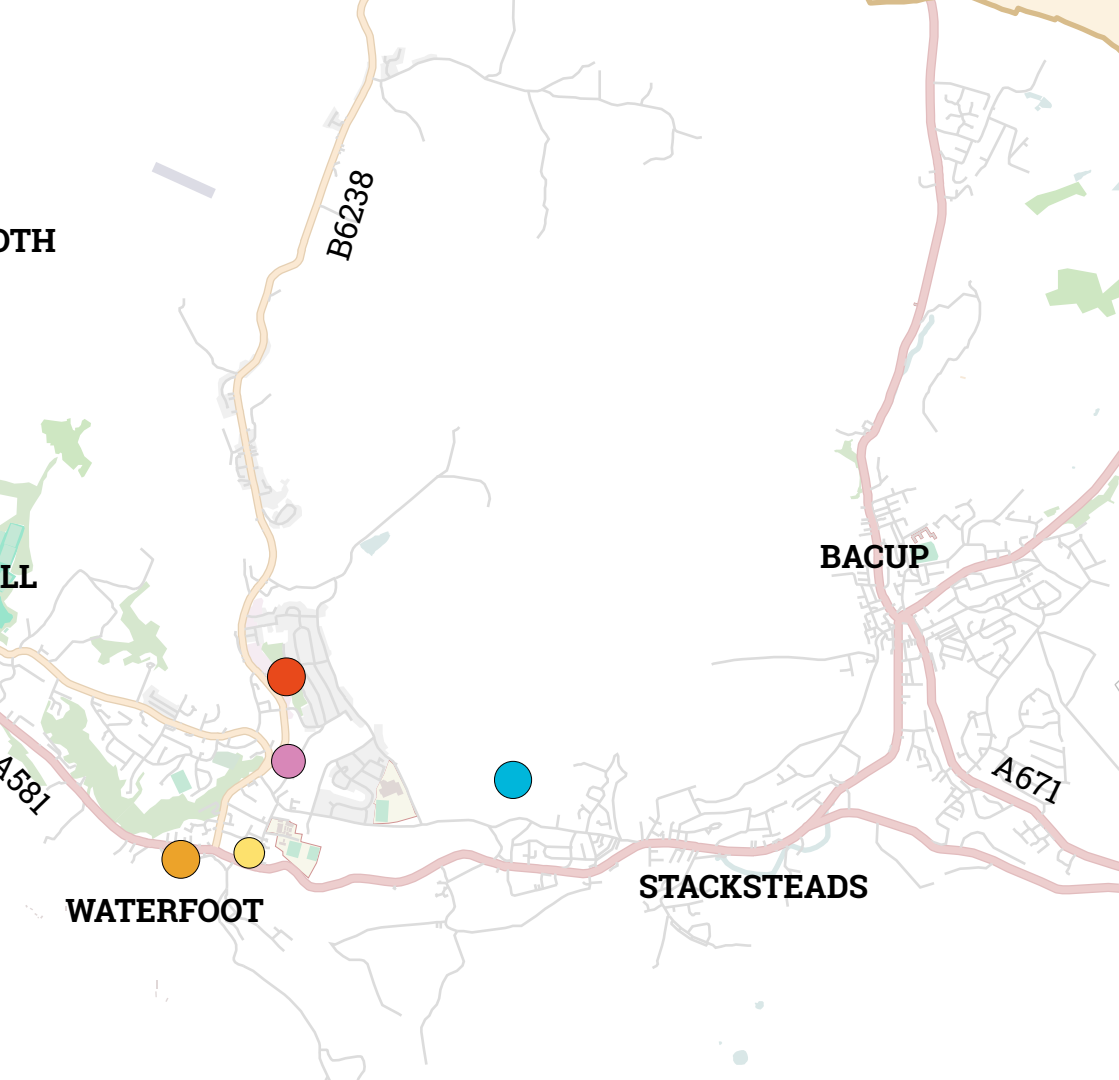
